- I. Chapter 94 report
 - The average flow was 132k per day. Tom will file a response
 - a. 2025 flow summary
 - highest peak was August 2, 2025 at 647k
 - b. Corrective Action Plan:
 - We are making progress but still have work to do.
 - The Chemical Plant averages 15k

 - 3% increase in cost for 2026
 - A motion was presented by Chairman Coleman to accept the increase and continue with Smart Cover, seconded by Supervisor Gradel, MCU.

 - The VFW does not have a grease trap
 - The Social Club and Fire Company – we will need the check for grease traps.

- Shelly has put together a sewer lateral inspection list that we can refer to
- Water Street – There will be an issue there if we plug up the pump station because it will push back into the houses.
